Trevor has inspired the whole FitzRoy team. Senior support worker Rosie said: “Trevor’s challenge has encouraged us to get outside a bit more and benefit from the exercise.”

The marathon has been a fantastic way to see some of his friends for outdoor visits, get fit and raise funds. Rosie adds, “He managed to push

through his fear of stairs to take a walk by the river.”

Not only did Trevor overcome his fear and complete the marathon challenge he’d set himself but he smashed through his original fundraising target too – amazing!



The people we support have their vote counted

Judith, Oliver and Jonathon, who live in our care home in Kent, joined hundreds of thousands of voters across the nation on 6 May and had their say.

Jonathon told us: "I think it is very important that everyone should have the chance to vote."

Care home deputy manager Michael said: "We held meetings every day leading up to election day for our residents to discuss what the different parties are standing for, and everyone had really open discussions."

"It's their opportunity to be heard and to share their voice just like everyone else in society. If we don't support our residents and make sure they have the information needed, we would be depriving them of that right. That is why we have made sure the people we support have all the information that they need so they can choose."

Kimberley, service manager of our Nottingham support at home service agreed. Her team support people with a range of mental health conditions to live in their own homes. "The people we support might feel that no one will listen to them or that their voice is not valued. We have to challenge that, and support them to feel informed and able to vote."





